## 1 Introduction

atvise® live is only accessible via the atvise® builder. It provides generated examples of objects, tapes, displays or server scripts in XML format to atvise® users. atvise® users optionally have the possibility to create example data and upload them via our upload form on our website. They can also browse and download existing examples and use them in their project.

The guidelines contain binding conditions to provide atvise® objects, types, displays and server scripts – only in XML format – for the users of atvise® live.

## 2 Providing content

On our website [www.atvise.com](http://www.atvise.com) every registered user is allowed to access the upload form from the menu 'Ressources/atvise® live' to provide content. All mandatory fields have to be filled out as described (changes for publishing reserved by Certec):

### 2.1 Title

Title of the provided content that will be displayed in the atvise® live category list.

### 2.2 Category

Pre-selection for the atvise® live category the content belongs to.

### 2.3 Target system

webMI, SCADA or both.

### 2.4 Short description

The short description is an introduction that describes the main functionality of the content.

### 2.5 Detailed description

This description contains detailed information on the content - e.g. the usage and item paths.

You have to quote the absolute path in the atvise® project of every item that is part of the imported content. This makes it easier for the user to see where the desired data will be imported to. Child items don't have to be quoted separately.

#### Examples:

Name: MainDisplay  
Type: Display  
Path: Server > My Server > DISPLAYS > MAIN

Name: WeatherStation  
Type: ObjectType  
Path: ObjectTypes

Name: speed  
Type: Node  
Path: Server > My Server > OBJECTS

The author of the example file can optionally add his/her contact for possible queries. The communication of both parties takes place with the complete exclusion of Certec.

Please see the licensing and copyright conditions in chapter 2.15, atvise® live terms and conditions, paragraph 2 'Ownership, Copyright and Grant of License'.

## 2.6 File version

Version number of the content (e.g. '1' or '3.4')

## 2.7 Tested browser version

List of browsers including the according version number(s) which were used for testing the content.

## 2.8 atvise® version

atvise® version used to create the content (e.g. '2.2' or '2.5.1').

## 2.9 Website

Author's company URL (starting with 'http://').

## 2.10 User information

The user data will automatically read from the data given by the user himself at the registration process.

## 2.11 Autor

Content's author.

## 2.12 Autor e-mail

Author's email address (for further inquiries on our part).

## 2.13 XML file

Content that can contain an object, a type, a process image or a whole project has to be provided as single XML file (\*.xml). [max. 16 MB]

## 2.14 Image

Every author has the possibility to implement the company's logo in the description. It will be displayed along with the provided content. Therefore a pixel graphic as PNG or JPG can be included. The size of the displayed image can be adjusted or clipped as needed by Certec.

## 2.15 atvise® live terms and conditions

Before transferring the data to Certec EDV GmbH the author has to agree to following terms and conditions (has to be accepted, when starting the upload form):

### atvise® live Terms and Conditions

Please read the atvise® live Terms and Conditions ("Terms and Conditions") carefully before you use atvise® live or upload, download, install or use atvise® live Components (as defined below).

#### 1. Preamble

These Terms and Conditions apply to all users ("User") of atvise® live. User refers to the individual or entity (acting through an authorized individual) which is using atvise® live as being displayed in the atvise® builder, additionally user refers to the individual or entity which is uploading, downloading, installing or using atvise® live Components. The term "Component" refers to all atvise® live components (e.g. scripts, graphics, libraries, documentations) that are distributed over atvise® live. The term "Copyright Holder" refers to the individual or entity that owns all or part of the intellectual property in and pertaining to the Component. The User acknowledges that he has read and understood these Terms and Conditions and agrees to be fully bound by them.

#### 2. Ownership, Copyright and Grant of License

All Components have to be licensed by the Copyright Holder under the 3-clause BSD license (license text template see below). This includes the obligation for the Copyright Holder and any other User to integrate the BSD license text in the source code of the Component or in a license file which is delivered with the Component.
